

## **ELECTRICITY GOVERNANCE RULES 2003**

### **GRID UPGRADE PLAN**

#### **400kV TRANSMISSION LINE WHAKAMARU–OTAHUHU**

On 27<sup>th</sup> April 2006, the Electricity Commission gave notice under rule 15.1 of section III of part F of the Electricity Governance Rules 2003 that it intended to decline to approve the reliability investment comprising a 400kV transmission line from Whakamaru to Otahuhu proposed in volume 2 of the grid upgrade plan submitted to the Electricity Commission by Transpower New Zealand Limited on 30 September 2005.

Transpower New Zealand Limited has advised the Electricity Commission that it intends to provide another proposal for the Electricity Commission's consideration, and that it no longer wishes to progress the specific 400kV proposal to which that notice relates.

Accordingly, the Board of the Electricity Commission has revoked the notice of intention issued on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2006.
