Bombay Bus Security Investment Proposal

On 12 March 2009, Transpower New Zealand Limited (**Transpower**) submitted to the Electricity Commission two investment proposals for approval under rule 13 of section III of part F of the Electricity Governance Rules 2003.

The first proposal (**Bombay Bus Security Investment Proposal**) has been submitted as a reliability investment, and involves the installation of a bus coupler to the 110kV substation at Bombay.
